3. The member details should be for the member who is paying the membership fee and from whose bank account (can be a joint account) the fee will be taken. The member’s full name and address are required and should match the member details on the application form. (Apologies that this duplicates the RPS Application form but this is an HMRC mandatory requirement).
4. The form must be signed and dated.
5. Mail the completed form back to the Treasurer at the address given.
6. If your situation changes such that you no longer pay enough income and/or capital gains tax to cover this and all other charitable donations you make then you are obligated to inform us as the Gift Aid declaration is no longer valid.
7. The Society will hold and process your personal data in accordance with its Privacy Policy.
